Province of Alberta Provincial Election Day is set for Monday, May 29, 2023 and will have to have a writ to call the election signed by the Alberta Governor General a minimum of 30 days from the May 1, 2023 is 30 day campaign.

Official Party status with Election Alberta requires minimum 44 candidates running as Independents and will all be registered with Election Alberta in Edmonton on day Election is called, We expect by Monday, May 1, 2023. It will be a short 30-day election.

All 44 Signed Candidate packages including and \$500.00 Candidate Deposit Payable to Chief Electoral Officer by Cash, Certified cheque/ bank or postal money order payable to "Government of Alberta."

Please have all completed signed candidate package with a \$500.00 deposit in my possession at my address for all 44 packages to be registered on election day call expected Monday, May 1, 2023. All Packages will need to be with Election Alberta Before **2pm, Wednesday, May 10, 2023** to be listed on the Election voting Ballot on May 29, 2023.

I will take all 44 plus completed Candidate Packages to Election Alberta office at suite 100, 11510 Kingsway NW, Edmonton, Ab T5G 2Y5.

A completed original Candidate Nomination Paper must be filed with the returning officer **before 2:00 pm** on Nomination Day (*the 10th day after the Writ of Election is issued*). **May 10, 2023** Late papers not accepted.

### **Timeframe to Collect Signatures**

• Independent candidates may start collecting signatures once the Writ of Election has been issued.

- 1) Bookkeeper for tracking campaign accounting of incomes and expenses.
- 2) Read rules for campaign donations from individuals and companies.
- 3) Campaign committee to organize literature, brochures, door knocking, sign delivery,
- 4) Contact Printing company for pricing on all brochures, lawn signs, etc. 3 color- Red, White & Reflex Blue
- 5) Lawn signs Coroplast Signs 16x24", double sided 3 color H-stand stakes.
- 6) Billboard Advertising signs - Coroplast Signs 48x96" 4'X8' single sided 3 Color
- 7) Bus / home fence signage - Coroplast Signs 48x48" 4'X4' Single sided 3 Color
- 8) Contact Canada post for pricing of delivering flyers in your Constituency possibly 1,2 or 3 drops? In a short 30-day campaign. Special reduced pricing for elections
- 9) All constituency polling and contacts from previous election can be provided by Election Alberta on XL program. I have an XL program designed for campaigns.
- 10) Laptop to track all contacts in polling stations.
- 11) Download Election Alberta XL campaign polling stations for your Constituency on your laptop.
- 12) Organize campaign workers from home with access to a computer on XL to track assigned polls identifying potential voters, requiring lawn signs and volunteers for door knocking.
- 13) Campaign Office would be an asset but will depend on your finances. You can work from your Home.

# Candidate Nomination Papers Instructions for Completion

## Printing the Papers

The *Candidate Nomination Papers* consists of four different components:

### *Elector Signature Page*

- You will need signatures from 25 eligible electors. Room is provided for 30 signatures in the package. If additional pages are needed to collect signatures, print additional elector signature pages.

### *Affidavit of Witness Page*

- You will need to print one page per witness, as each witness must complete an affidavit for the signature pages they have witnessed.

### *Candidate's Address for Service Page*

- You will need to print one copy of this page.

### *Affidavit of Candidate Page*

- You will need to print one copy of this page.

You may also obtain printed nomination papers from the returning office once the Writ of Election has been issued.

## Preparing to Collect Signatures

Candidates must be nominated by at least 25 eligible electors:

- It is recommended that you collect more than the 25 required signatures, in case some are excluded during the review process.
- Signatures can be collected by the candidate or any other eligible elector, on the candidate's behalf.
- Witnesses must be eligible electors in Alberta. They are not required to reside in the electoral division.
- Each page must contain the candidate's name and political party affiliation (if any).
- The witness should print their name on the bottom of each page, as well as the date range of which the signatures were collected.
- Any number of witnesses may be used to collect signatures. However, each witness must complete an *Affidavit of Witness* form.
- All pages should be numbered correctly. E.g.: 1 of 3, 2 of 3, etc..

## Timeframe to Collect Signatures

- Candidates that have been endorsed by a registered provincial political party may start collecting signatures once they are officially endorsed.
- Independent candidates may start collecting signatures once the Writ of Election has been issued.
- All signatures must be collected prior to the close of nominations.

## Collecting Signatures

Witnesses must confirm the person nominating the candidate is an eligible elector in the electoral division in which the candidate is seeking nomination (see image below):

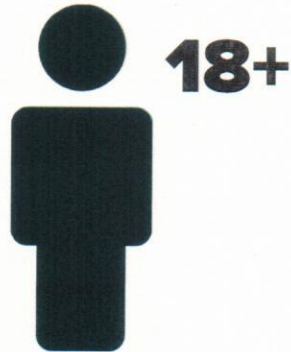
- Be sure the printed name of each elector is legible.
- When collecting addresses, the residential or physical address must be collected. Post office boxes and mailing addresses will not be accepted. Postal codes are not required.
- Be sure to have the elector sign the form.
- Candidates and witnesses can sign as electors, provided they reside in the electoral division in which the candidate is seeking nomination and they do not witness their own signature.

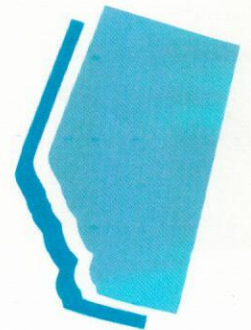

## Completing Witness Affidavits

After a witness has finished collecting signatures, they must complete an *Affidavit of Witness*.

- Print the name of the witness and the name of the candidate on the lines indicated.
- The witness must swear (or affirm) that they have confirmed the eligibility of electors and witnessed the signatures on the applicable nomination pages.
- The witness must take an oath and sign the form in front of a Commissioner of Oaths.
- The Returning Officer can complete the Commissioner of Oath section. Returning Offices are open once the Writ of Election has been issued. The witness swearing or affirming the oath must be present at the time the oath is taken.

## Candidate Address for Service

- An address must be provided at which documents from Elections Alberta can be sent to the candidate, both during and after the election.
- It is recommended to use the permanent residential address of the candidate or the official agent. This address will not be published.

## Candidate Nomination Endorsement

- Please indicate if the candidate is endorsed by a registered political party or is running as an Independent. Specify the electoral division in which the candidate is seeking nomination.

## Appointment of Official Agent

- All candidates are required to appoint an elector as an official agent.
- The duties of an official agent are those prescribed by the candidate. The official agent may not act as the Chief Financial Officer, unless they have been appointed in that role on the candidate's *Registration of Candidate* under the *Election Finances and Contributions Disclosure Act* form.
- The address and telephone number of the official agent will be published on the Elections Alberta's website.
- The email address will not be published.
- The official agent must sign and date the appointment.

## Affidavit of Candidate

- Candidates must swear (or affirm) that they are eligible for nomination, consent to their nomination, confirm the appointment of their official agent and confirm their political party affiliations (if any).
- The candidate must take the oath and sign the form in front of a Commissioner of Oaths.
- The Returning Officer can complete the Commissioner of Oath section. Returning Offices are open once the Writ of Election has been issued. The candidate swearing or affirming the oath must be present at the time the oath is taken.

## Contents of the Ballot

The candidate must state how they wish their name to appear on the ballot.

- Each ballot shall set out the name of each candidate together with:
  - a) the name of the registered political party for which the candidate is the candidate, or
  - b) the word "Independent" if the candidate is not a candidate for a registered political party.
- Rules and formatting for setting out candidate names on the ballot are found in section 83(3) of the *Election Act*.

## Submitting Nomination Papers

- Returning Offices will be open once the Writ of Election is issued to accept nomination papers.
- Candidate identification will be required to be presented to the Returning Officer at the time the nomination papers are filed. Copies of the identification are acceptable.
- Collect all completed **originals** of the Candidate Nomination Papers.
- Ensure all affidavits have been completed or that arrangements have been made for their completion with the Returning Officer.
- Completed *Candidate Nomination Papers* must be submitted **before 2p.m. on Nomination Day**.

Original forms are to be submitted in person to the Returning Office in the electoral division in which the candidate is seeking nomination.

Late or incomplete papers will not be accepted.

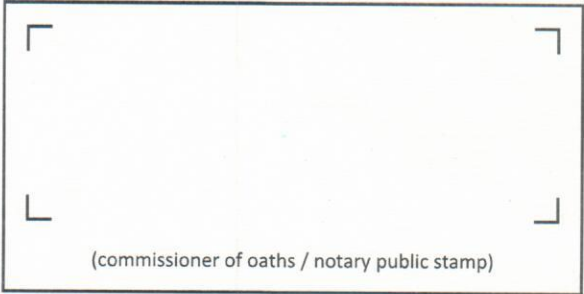
